"Sai Nath University, Ranchi, Jharkhand" represented herein by its Vice Chancellor Dr. S.P. Agarwal (hereinafter referred as "SNU", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

WHEREAS:

A) JGTR has been setup by the Government of Jharkhand with Central Assistance from Ministry of MSME, Government of India and is aimed for imparting training in the field of design & manufacturing. It is an ISO 9001:2008, ISO 50001:2011, and ISO 29990:2010-12 certified institute with separate training and production wings. The broad areas of specialization of JGTR are as follows:

- - Conducting AICTE approved 4 years Diploma in Tool & Die Making course (Equivalent to Diploma in Mechanical)
- Various industry oriented skill development courses in the area of Machinist, Welder, Fitter, Electrician, CNC, CAD/CAM, TQM, Inspection & Quality Control, 5S, Six Sigma, CNC Maintenance, PLC Programming, Mobile phone repairing, Computer hardware & Network management, etc.
- Training on latest design software like Auto CAD, DELCAM, Pro/ENGINEER, CATIA, HyperWorks, STAADPro, etc.
- Having full-fledged production department equipped with a comprehensive range of imported and indigenous CNC machine like CNC Turning, CNC Machining Centre, Coordinate Measuring Machine, CNC EDM, CNC Wire cut, etc. including latest CAD/CAM.
- Design and Manufacturing of moulds, press tools, jigs & fixtures, gauges, die casting dies and precision machining.

B) "SNU", The Sai Nath University, Ranchi has been established and incorporated by Jharkhand State Legislature through its official Gazette and recognized as per section 2(f) of UGC Act 1956.

The university till offer courses in different disciplines like Engineering, law, Social Science, Travel & Tourism, Hospitality, Allied Health, Management, Communication, Jewellery Management etc. rolled out in phases. **The serene campus of the University is located at "Jirawar, Chandway-Kuchu Road, Ormanjhi, Ranchi, Jharkhand".**

- C) The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation, and competitiveness of an industrial facility. Both JGTR and SNU believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- D) JGTR and SNU believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- E) Both JGTR and SNU intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- F) Both JGTR and SNU, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interest.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both JGTR and SNU are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations to achieve their Institutional objectives. They shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another. All the expenditures involved for the same will be paid by the second party SNU.
- 1.2 JGTR and SNU co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculties of JGTR and SNU providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry. It will help the faculties of JGTR and SNU suitably customize the course curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- 1.3 SNU shall plan the Skill/Technology/Entrepreneurship training for its students in consultation with JGTR and ensure that the students to go through the training provided by JGTR. The fees for training programmes shall be mutually decided based on the relevant factors and considering the long term objectives of the Business Agreement. A certificate will be issued by JGTR to the students on the successful completion of the training programme as per the JGTR guidelines.



- 1.4 JGTR will permit the Faculty and Students of SNU to visit its laboratories and manufacturing facilities. Hence, the Faculty and Students of SNU will get an opportunity to see and learn the application of the latest technologies and global best practices.
- 1.5 JGTR shall extend its support and facilities to the students of SNU to complete/fabricate their final year projects. All the expenditures involved for the same will be paid by the second party which shall be mutually decided. JGTR shall appoint a suitable guide as a mentor for such students.
- 1.6 JGTR shall extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecture to the students of SNU on the technology trends in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 1.7 Both JGTR and SNU have agreed to extend their facilities to carry out the joint research/project/consultancy activities in the field of Design and Manufacturing. JGTR shall permit the Faculties of SNU to utilize the facilities available with JGTR and its branches/extension centers for conducting experiments/analysis for research purpose at minimal cost.
- 1.8 Both JGTR and SNU shall appoint a nodal officer for mutual correspondence and managing the activities under this Understanding.

For Second party.SNU: Shri

CLAUSE 2: GENERAL AGREEMENT

- 2.1 There is no financial commitment on the part of both the parties JGTR and SNU to take up any programme mentioned in this MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.
- 2.2 SNU will provide 25% discount on the course fee, if any faculty or students from JGTR going for higher education at SNU.
- 2.3 SNU may conduct campus interview for recruitment of Technical manpower from JGTR.
- 2.4 It is expressly agreed that JGTR and SNU are acting under this Understanding as independent contractors, and their relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership.
- 2.5 Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- 2.6 Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this Understanding to make agreements of any kind in the name of or

binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

- 2.7 Nothing Party contained in this Understanding shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.
- 2.8 This MOU is valid with effect from the date of the last signature at the end of the document.
- 2.9 This MOU will be valid for three years and may be renewed on mutual agreement.
- 2.10 Either Party may terminate this MOU unilaterally (without assigning any reason) by giving an advanced notice of one month to the other in writing. In the event of termination, both Parties have to discharge their obligations.
- 2.11 This agreement may not be amended without the prior written consent of both the Parties JGTR and SNU.
