

Anti-Ragging

Ragging is strictly prohibited within the University campus and Hostels. The University maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards any form of ragging—whether verbal, physical, or psychological. In accordance with the UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 any student found guilty of participation in or abetment of ragging shall face severe disciplinary action, which may include suspension, expulsion, or legal proceedings as per law. The University has established an Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure a safe and supportive environment for all students. Freshers are encouraged to report any incident of ragging immediately and without fear.

All complaints will be treated with confidentiality and prompt action will be taken.
